Highland Cattle Scotty



Introduction / General information

The bookmark has a total length of about 37 cm. Depending on the thickness of the wool, the length can vary a bit, you can also make it shorter or longer depending on your preference.

It is not allowed to exchange, pass on, duplicate, sell or otherwise publish the whole pattern or parts of it.

You will need following material

Tools:

- Crochet Hook 2.5 mm
- Needle
- Scissors

For this bookmark, following wool was used:

Hobbii Amigo (100% HB Acryl, Weight: 50g, Meterage: 175 m, Yarn Weight: light).

Used Colors:

- Delicate Rose (A47)
- Cognac (A39)
- Ecu (A02)
- Chocolate (A06)

Other needed material:

- Polyfill
- Teddy bear eyes 10 mm blue

You will use following techniques

- Magic ring
- Single crochet
- Chain stich
- Slip stich

- Half Double Crochet
- Double Crochet
- Increase
- Decrease

- Colour change
- Sewing
- Attach/bind strings

Abbreviations

sc: single crochet
dc: double crochet
hdc: half double crochet

ch: chain stich
slst: slip stich

inc: increase (make two stitches out of one)
dec: decrease (knit two together)

Let's start! Part 1: head



Start with **Delicate Rose** and work in spiral rounds (do not cut the thread):

Round 1: 6 sc into the magic ring (6)

Round 2: inc every sc (12)

Round 3: 6x [1 sc, 1 inc] (18)

Round 4: 6x [2 sc, 1 inc] (24)

Round 5-6 (2 Rounds): 24 sc (24)



Change color to **Cognac**

Round 7-10 (4 Rounds): 24 sc (24)

Round 11: 6x [3 sc, 1 inc] (30)

Rounds 12: 30 sc (30)

Round 13: 6x [4 sc, 1 inc] (36)

Round 14: 20 sc, 3 sc into the back loop only, 13 sc (36)

Round 15-17 (3 Rounds): 19 sc, 5 sc into the back loop only, 12 sc (36)



Now attach the teddy bear eyes: One row below the first row where you only crocheted into the back loop of the stitches, with a distance of 4 stitches between the eyes.

Round 18: 3x [4 sc, 1 dec], 1 sc, 6 sc into the back loop only, 4 sc, 1 dec, 3 sc, 1 dec (31)

Round 19: 16 sc, 6 sc into the back loop only, 9 sc (31)

Round 20: 3x [3 sc, 1 dec], 2 sc, 1 dec into the back loop only, 4 sc into the back loop only, 3 sc, 1 dec, 2 sc, 1 dec (26)

Round 21: 8x [1sc, 1 dec], 1 sc (17 sc)

Round 22: 1 dec only



Fill the head with polyfill and take it in hand so that the last crocheted stitch is the rightest stitch, and the two rows lay parallel to each other.



Now insert the needle into the first stitch and the stitch directly opposite (not the last crocheted stitch), pick up the thread, pull it through the pair of stitches, and crochet both stitches together with 1 sc.



In this way, crochet all opposite pairs of stitches together. The head is crocheted together with a total of 8 sc (8).

Do not cut the thread and continue with the body.



Part 2: Body



For the body work in rows in **Cognac**, without cutting the thread.

1. Row: 1 turning chain, 1 inc, 6 sc, 1 inc (10)

2. Row: 1 turning chain, 1 inc, 8 sc, 1 inc (12)

3. Row: 1 turning chain, 1 inc, 10 sc, 1 inc (14)

4. Row: 2 turning chain, 1 dc inc, 12 dc, 1 dc inc (16)

5.-12. Row (8 Rows): 2 turning chain, 16 dc (16)

13. Row: 2 turning chain, 2 dc zus, 12 dc, 1 dc dec (14)

14.-19. Row (6 Rows): 2 turning chain, 14 dc (14)

20. Row: 2 turning chain, 1 dc inc, 12 dc, 1 dc inc (16)

21.-26. Row (6 Rows): 2 turning chain, 16 dc (16)

27. Row: 2 turning chain, 1 dc dec, 12 dc, 1 dc dec (14)

28. Row: 2 turning chain, 1 dc dec, 10 dc, 1 dc dec (12)

29. Row: 1 turning chain, 6 sc, crochet tail (10 chain stitch, 1 slst into the 4th stitch from the hook, 6 slst), 1 sc into the next stitch on the body, 5 sc.

Cut the thread and sew it.

Part 3: Arms



For the arms, work in spiral rounds in **Chocolate**.

1. Round: 6 sc into the magic ring (6)

2. Round: 6x [1 inc] (12)

3. Round: 6x [1 sc, 1 inc] (18)

4.-6. Round (3 Rounds): 18 sc (18)

Color change to **Cognac**, cut the **Chocolate** thread generously to form the toes later on (leave the **Chocolate** thread outside of the foot).



7.-8. Round (2 Rounds): 18 sc (18)

9. Round: 3x [4 sc, 1 dec] (15)

10.-11. Round (2 Rounds): 15 sc (15)

Fill the hoof (only the hoof) with polyfill. Then shape the hoof with the **Chocolate** thread: pierce the thread once through the center of the hoof, pass it around the hoof, and pierce it again in the same place. Repeat at least 2x and tighten the thread until a split hoof is formed. Then separate the chocolate colored part of the leg from the rest of the leg with a seam (see photo, the needle shows where to sew). Finally sew the thread.



12.-16. Round (5 Rounds): 15 sc (15)

17. Round: 3x [3 sc, 1 dec] (12)

18.-24. Round (7 Rounds): 12 sc (12)

25. Round: only crochet 2 sc (the last stitch should be on the very right end of the arm when flattening the arm).

Fill the arm with polyfill (do not overstuff) and crochet it together with 5 sc (see head).

Continue working in rows.

26. Row: 2 turning chain, 2 dc, 2 hdc, 1 sc (5)

27. Row 1 turning chain, 1 sc, 2 hdc, 2 dc (5)

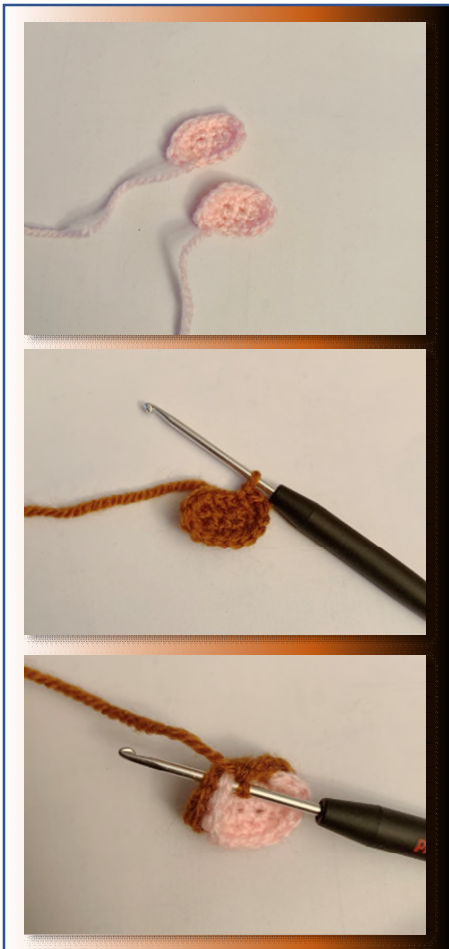
Cut the thread generously, pull it through, and use it for sewing the arm on the body.

Part 4: Legs



Crochet the legs in the same way as the arms, but only up to and including row 25. Fill the legs and sew them together like the arms. Cut the thread generously to use it later for sewing the legs on the body.

Part 5: Ears



For the ears work in **Delicate Rose**.

- 1. Round:** 4 chain stitc, 1 sc into the second stitch from the hook, 1 sc, 1 sc triple (!), 1 sc, 1 inc (8)
- 2. Round:** 1 inc, 1 sc, 3x [1 inc], 2 sc, 1 inc (13)
- 3. Round:** only (1 hdc, 1 dc, 1 hdc) into the first stitch, 1 slst

Repeat round 1-3 in **Cognac**. Place both pieces on top of each other (the crocheted part in **Delicate Rose** is on top.). Crochet the next round through both crochet parts at the same time (with **Cognac**).

- 4. Round:** 1st sc should be in the same stitch where the slst was crocheted, 2 sc, 5x [1 inc], 4 sc, 1 hdc inc, 1 dc inc, 1 hdc inc, 1 sc, close the round with 1 slst (24)

Cut the thread generously. Before sewing, weave the thread a bit to the bottom, so that it is at the lower end of the ear.

Part 6: Horns

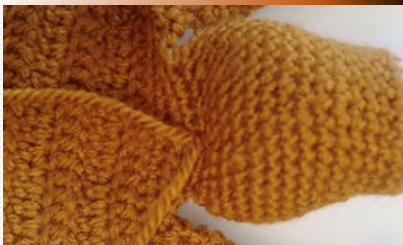


For the horns work in **Ecrú** in spiral rounds.

- 1. Round:** 5 sc into the magic ring (5)
- 2. Round:** 5 sc (5)
- 3. Round:** 1 inc, 4 sc (6)
- 4. Round:** 6 sc (6)

- 5. Round:** 1 inc, 5 sc (7)
- 6. Round:** 1 inc, 6 sc (8)
- 7.+8. Round (2 Rounds):** 8 sc (8)
- 9. Round:** 2x [1 inc, 3 sc] (10)
- 10. Round:** 10 sc (10)

Nearly done! Part 7 – sew all parts together



Arme: Die Arme am Körper annähen, mit Abstand von 1 Reihe vom Hals.

Legs: sew the legs to the body with a distance of 1 stitch from the tail.

Form eyes: Pierce with a thread from the lower neck part (chin) under the first eye, from there inside the head to the second, and then again from the same hole out of the head, where you have passed the beginning of the thread. Tighten the thread a little, knot it, and cut it generously after the knot. Push the knot inside the head.

Horns: Sew the horns to the right and left of the stitches crocheted only into the back loop. They should be about 2 rows away from the neck where the head was crocheted together. When sewing, weave the thread once along the side of the horns facing each other and tighten a little before sewing so that the horns curve inward a little.

Ears: Fold each ear at the bottom and sew them together. Then sew the ears right next to the horns.



Hair: Cut 36 threads (12 cm long) in **Chocolate**. With the crochet hook pierce through the lowest loop on the head, pull the thread (shaped as a U) through and knot. If the hair should not be so bushy, it is possible to not knot hair to all of the loops. Shorten the hair a little and, if you wish, use a needle to twist it up a little.





Tail: For the tail, cut four 10 cm long threads in **Chocolate**. Pull the threads through the loop on the tail (see photo) and knot them. Separate the individual strands with a needle.
