

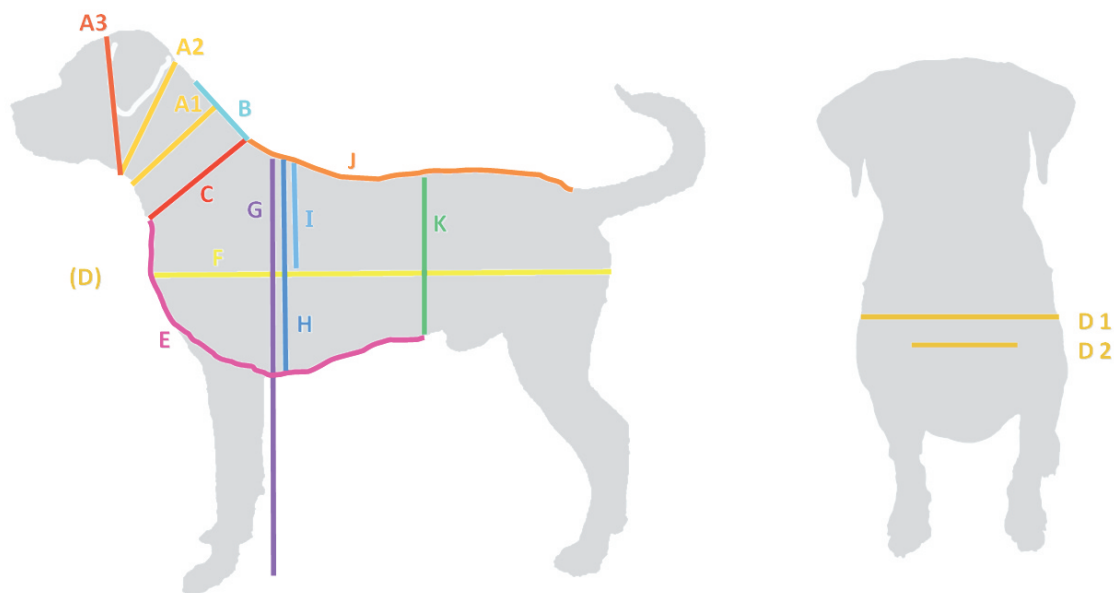
MEASUREMENTS FOR DOGS

Unless otherwise stated, pull the measuring tape snug – but not too tight – and don't add extra ease.

A1	Neck circumference (e.g. for collar with buckle, bandana, Infinity scarf) 2 fingers should fit between the neck and the tape measure.
A2	Neck circumference, slimmest (e.g. for slip collar) Usually directly behind the ears.
A3	Head circumference (e.g. for slip collar, sweater, infinity scarf) Broadest, usually directly in front of the ears.
B	Neck length (e.g. for infinity scarf, coat collar, hood)
C	Circumference neck/back (e.g. for sweater, bath robe, coat, harness)
D1	Chest and shoulders front (e.g. for sweater, bath robe, coat, harness) For Norwegian harness measure around up to the intersections with H .
D2	Chest width (e.g. for chest/belly protection, harness) Between the front legs
E	Length of chest and belly protection (e.g. for sweater, bath robe, coat, harness)
F	Total length (e.g. for sweater, bath robe, coat)
G	Height (at withers) up to 40 cm [15"] = small / up to 60 cm [23"] = medium / up to 70 cm [27"] = large / above 70 cm [27"] = giant
H	Chest/belly circumference (e.g. for sweater, bath robe, coat, harness) Distance from front legs: 6 cm [2.4"] small, 10 cm [4"] medium, 15 cm [6"] large dogs
I	Length at withers (e.g. for Norwegian harness) Across the back up to the intersection of D1 and H
J	Back length (e.g. for sweater, bath robe, coat) from C to the tail or to your desired length for a coat
K	Waist circumference (e.g. for sweater, bath robe, coat, harness, belly band, panties)
