 They look at the sea all day.

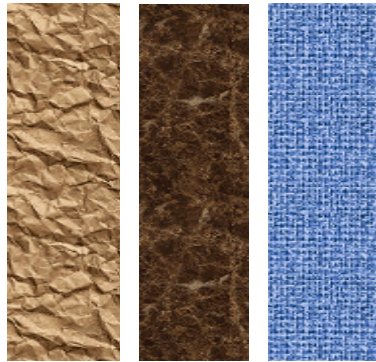
As long as it takes to pass
